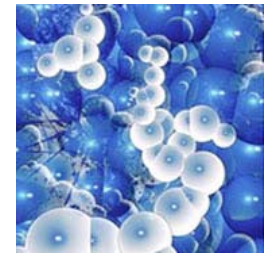
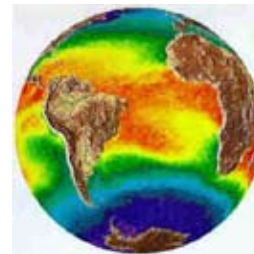
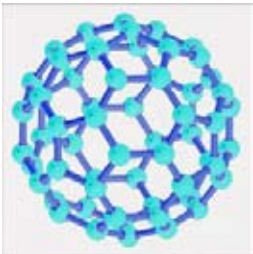


# Debating Science...
