CSPO hosted the inaugural meeting of the International Nanotechnology and Society Network (INSN) January 26-28 on the ASU campus. The goals of the INSN include enhancing communication among groups in various countries that are conducting research on the societal implications of NSE; facilitating international comparisons of NSE research, regulation, and outcomes; convening an annual or biennial international meeting on the societal implications of NSE; developing international exchange programs for graduate students, research fellows, and faculty; and jointly pursuing resources to support collaborative activities.

Participants in the inaugural meeting were drawn from the UK (Lancaster University; Cambridge University; Oxford University; DEMOS), the Netherlands (Universteit Twente), Japan (National Institute for Materials Science), Brazil (Universidade Federal de Santa Catarina; Federal University of Parana), Mexico (Universidad Autonoma de Zacatecas), Canada (University of Saskatchewan), and the U.S. (Arizona State University; Georgia Institute of Technology; Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute; University of Colorado; University of Wisconsin).
