**Quantitative Data Analysis**

The purpose of the Quantitative Data Analysis course is for students to (a) practice and improve their skills in quantitative data analysis including survey research and comparative state/country/city studies (and possibly time series); and (b) develop and finish a publishable-quality paper that uses quantitative analysis. Each student will develop his/her own research question related to some aspect of social inquiry, develop the data set to study it (using survey-monkey, for example, or compiling a comparative data set.) We focus very specifically on the methodologies that students are actually using in their papers. This is a highly interactive class as students work on their own projects but also are expected to help one another as they critique, brainstorm, identify literature, etc. for the other students.
